

## South Texas Hereford Assn. Fall Results

The South Texas Hereford Association hosted its fall sale on October 27, 2007. The sale was held at the Beeville Livestock Commission in Beeville, Texas. Thirty-nine bulls and 460 females were sold.

The thirty-nine bulls averaged \$2,392.00 per head. The Grand Champion honors in the Hereford Bull Division were taken by Honeymoon Herefords of Marble Falls, Texas. Engstrom Brothers of Garwood, Texas, purchased the champion bull for \$2500.00. Weldon Winsauer of Beeville, Texas consigned the Reserve Champion Bull. Turkey Track Ranch of Wharton, Texas purchased the Reserve Champion for \$2100.00. Other top selling bulls included the following: Case Ranch, El Dorado, Texas - \$4,400.00, \$3,900.00, and \$3,700.00; Charles Moscatelli, Victoria, Texas - \$3,500.00 and \$2,900.00; Brown Ranches, Beeville, Texas - \$2,900.00 and \$2,800.00; Honeymoon Herefords - \$3,400.00; and Weldon Winsauer - \$2,500.00 Other Bull Consignors at the sale include Dr. Larry Karrh, Siesta Herefords, Jason Irby, and Dr. A.F. Day, Jr.

Twenty Bred Hereford Females averaged \$1,335.00 per head. Brown Ranches, Beeville, Texas had the Grand Champion pen and the Reserve Champion pen. Helm Ranch of San Antonio purchased the Grand Champion pen for \$7,000.00 and the Reserve Champion pen for \$7,250.00.

Open Hereford Females averaged \$1,027.56. There were 34 registered females and 5 purebred females. Schmidt Ranch of Hondo, Texas, had the Grand Champion pen. The pen of five was purchased by Edward Roeder of Yorktown for \$6,250.00. Wesley Thueret of Kenedy, Texas had the Reserve Champion pen. The 5 females were purchased by Jeff Granger of Sulphur, La. for \$4,875.00.

The True F-1 Pairs Grand Champion and the Reserve Champions pens both came from J-S Cattle Service of Waelder, Texas. Zelda Walker of Sheridan, Texas, purchased the Grand Champion pen of 5 females for \$10,00.00. The Reserve Champion pen of 5 was purchased by Leo Casas III of Beeville, Texas, for \$7,750.00. True F-1 Pairs averaged \$1,579.51 on 61 head.

The Stubenthal Brothers of Skidmore, Texas, had the Grand Champion and the Reserve Champion pens of True F-1 Bred Females. All the females were bred to Angus bulls and both pens were purchased by P.A. Albrecht of Goliad. The Grand Champion pen of 6 sold for \$11,400.00 and the Reserve Champion pen of 5 sold for \$12,00.00. The average per head was \$1,329.46 on 194 head sold.

Denny Joe Wiatrek of Poth, Texas, had the True Open F-1 Females Grand Champion pen of 5 black baldies . They were purchased by Ben D. Deason of Stockdale, Texas for \$4,500.00. Edward Roeder of Yorktown, Texas had the Reserve Champion pen. Jacob Lane, 5 J Ranch, Carmine, Texas purchased the pen of 6 for \$6,000.00. The True Open F-1 Females averaged \$852.95 on 146 head sold.

Volume buyers were: Frank Helvey of Hondo; Robert Nilson of El Campo; Leo Casas III of Beeville; Houston Munson of Gonzales; P.A. Albrecht of Goliad, Rick Day of San Antonio, and Helm Ranch of San Antonio.
