

South Texas Hereford Assn. Announces Fall Sale Results

The South Texas Hereford Association hosted its annual fall sale on October 30, 2010. The sale was held at the Beeville Livestock Commission in Beeville, Texas. There were 261 head sold in this sale.

Forty bulls averaged a record breaking \$2,863.00 per head. This surpassed the October 2005 record of \$2,447 per bull. Grand Champion honors were taken by Case Ranch of Eldorado, Texas. N.R. Johnston located in Kenedy, Texas, purchased the bull for \$4,400.00. Schmidt Herefords of Hondo, Texas, consigned the Reserve Champion bull. Griffith Land & Cattle Co. of Skidmore, Texas, bought the animal for \$3,900. Other top selling bull consignors included: Case Herefords, Eldorado, Texas, \$3,660; \$3,500; \$3,400; and \$3,300; \$3,200; and \$3,000; Schmidt Herefords, Hondo, Texas, \$4,000; \$3,900; and \$3,000; Weldon Winsauer, Beeville, Texas, \$3,700 and \$3,000; Walker Herefords, La Grange, Texas, \$3,600 and \$3,500; and Charles Moscatelli, Victoria, Texas, \$3,500. Other bull consignors included Brown Ranches of Beeville, Texas, and Cow Creek Ranch of Weesatche, Texas.

Grand Champion Open Hereford Females Pen of 5 consigned by Wesley Theuret of Kenedy, Texas, brought \$950 per head. Edward Roeder of Yorktown, Texas, purchased the grand champion pen for \$4,750. McDonald Bar 6 of Mathis, Texas, had the Reserve Champion Pen of 5. The open Hereford females brought an average of \$1,120 on 24 head.

Randy and Stacy Nichols of Port Lavaca, Texas, consigned the Grand Champion F-1 Pairs Pen of 5, which brought \$1,900 per head. Keith Foxell of Yoakum, Texas, purchased the pen for \$9,500. Reserve Champion honors, which sold for \$1,300 per head, went to W.D. Cattle Co. of Floresville, Texas. Mr. Foxell also purchased this pen for \$6,500.

Grand Champion True F-1 Bred Females Pen of 5 brought \$1,500 per head. The Stubenthal Brothers of Skidmore, Texas, had the championship pen. Robert Nilson of El Campo, Texas, purchased this pen for \$7,500. N.R. Johnston of Kenedy, Texas, consigned the Reserve Champion pen, which brought \$1,700 per head. Mr. Nilson bought the pen of 5 for \$8,500. The average for True F-1 Bred Females was \$1,328.00 on 101 head.

True Open F-1 Females Grand Champion Pen of 5 was awarded to Randy and Stacy Nichols of Port Lavaca, Texas. They brought \$1,400.00 per head. Wesley McAda from Hallettsville, Texas, purchased the pen for \$7,000. Edward Roeder of Yorktown, Texas consigned the Reserve Champion pen of 5 that sold for \$1,250 per head. Ronnie Brzozowski of Gonzales, Texas, purchased the pen for \$6,250.00. Average on 79 head was \$831.00.

Griffith Land and Cattle of Skidmore, Texas, was the volume bull buyer. The female volume buyers at the sale included the following: Robert Nilson of El Campo, Texas; Keith Foxell of Yoakum, Texas; Jake Daniel of Eagle Lake, Texas; Billy Polasek of Shiner, Texas; Robert Tumlinson of San Antonio, Texas; and Audra Henke of Port Lavaca, Texas.
