2011 South Texas Hereford Association Fall Sale Press Release

The South Texas Hereford Association hosted its annual fall sale on October 29, 2011. The sale was held at the Beeville Livestock Commission in Beeville, Texas. There were 306 head sold in this sale.

Forty-two bulls averaged \$2,521.00 per head. Grand Champion honors were taken by Case Ranch of Eldorado, Texas. Mary Martin located in Shiner, Texas, purchased the bull for \$3,500.00. Case Ranch also consigned the Reserve Champion bull. Robert Johnston of Victoria, Texas, bought the animal for \$2,500.00. Other top selling bull consignors included: Case Ranch Herefords, Eldorado, Texas, \$6,000; \$4,000; \$3,400; \$3,250; \$3,100; \$3,000; and \$2,800; Schmidt Herefords, Hondo, Texas, \$2,800 and \$2,700. Other bull consignors included Winsauer Herefords of Beeville, Texas, and Dry Creek Ranch of San Angelo, Texas.

Hereford pairs averaged \$2,450 per head. Charles Moscatelli of Victoria, Texas, was awarded Grand Champion Bred Hereford Females Pen of 5, which sold for \$1,400 per head. Edward Roeder of Yorktown, Texas, purchased the winning pen for \$7,000. Mr. Moscatelli also won Reserve Champion Bred Hereford Females Pen of 5 that sold for \$1,400 per head. Scott Straube of Yorktown, Texas, purchased the females for \$7,000. The 27 head of bred Hereford females averaged \$1,162 per head.

Grand Champion Open Hereford Females Pen of 5 consigned by Winsauer Herefords of Beeville, Texas, brought \$750 per head. George Jendrzey of Floresville, Texas, purchased the grand champion pen for \$3,750. Dennis Reitz of Weesatche, Texas, had the Reserve Champion Pen of 5, which brought \$725 per head. James Landrum of Beeville, Texas, bought the pen of females for \$3,625. The open Hereford females averaged \$738 on 10 head.

The eleven true F-1 pairs averaged \$1,436 per head. Grand Champion True F-1 Bred Females Pen of 5 brought \$1,400 per head. Stubenthal Brothers of Skidmore, Texas, had the championship pen. Ralph Dickinson of Yoakum, Texas, purchased this pen for \$7,000. N.R. Johnston of Kenedy, Texas, consigned the Reserve Champion pen of True F-1 Bred Females, which brought \$1,275 per head. Gentry Land and Cattle of Corpus Christi,

Texas, bought the pen of 5 for \$6,375. The average for True F-1 Bred Females was \$1,101 on 148 head.

True Open F-1 Females Grand Champion Pen of 5 was awarded to Cabeza Cattle Co. of Nixon, Texas. They brought \$985 per head. Audra Henke from Port Lavaca, Texas, purchased the pen for \$4,925. Cabeza Cattle Co. also consigned the Reserve Champion pen of 5 that sold for \$1,000 per head. Choctaw Cattle Co. of Sunset, Louisiana, purchased the pen for \$5,000. Average on 66 head was a \$942.

Nopalosa Farm of Laredo, Texas, and W.E. Butler of Nixon, Texas, were the volume bull buyers. The female volume buyers at the sale included the following: Gentry Land and Cattle of Corpus Christi, Texas; Robert Gayle of Goliad, Texas; Audra Henke of Port Lavaca, Texas; Ralph Dickenson of Yoakum, Texas; and Mike Adams of Navasota, Texas.

Capital Farm Credit , Livengood Feeds, and Davy Ranch Supply sponsored the sale.
