Press Release

The South Texas Hereford Association hosted its annual spring sale on February 6, 2010. The sale was held at the Beeville Livestock Commission in Beeville, Texas. There were 295 head sold in this sale.

Forty-three bulls average \$2,133.00 per head. Grand Champion honors were taken by Weldon Winsauer of Beeville, Texas. J.M. Power Ranch located in Goliad, Texas, purchased the bull for \$6,000. Mr. Winsauer also consigned the Reserve Champion bull. N.R. Johnston of Kenedy, Texas, bought the animal for \$3,500. Other top selling bull consignors included: Case Herefords, Eldorado, Texas, \$2,800; \$2,500; \$2,450; and \$2,200; Honeymoon Herefords, Marble Falls, Texas, \$2,350; Schmidt Herefords, Hondo, Texas, \$2,200; \$2,100; and \$2,000; Brown Ranches, Beeville, Texas, \$2,200 and \$2,000; and Charles Moscatelli, Victoria, Texas \$2,000.

Grand Champion Hereford Pairs Pen of 5 came from Honeymoon Herefords of Marble Falls, Texas. The pen of 5 brought \$1,575.00 per head. Dennis Reitz of Weesatche, Texas, purchased the pen for \$7,875. Hereford pairs averaged \$1,575.00 on 5 head.

Bred Hereford Females Grand Champion Pen of 5 from Weldon Winsauer, Beeville, Texas, sold for \$1,600 per head. Reg Othold of Shiner, Texas, purchased the pen for \$8,000. Denny Wiatrek of Poth, Texas, consigned the Reserve Champion pen of females that sold for \$1,275 per head. Dennis Reitz purchased this pen for \$6,375. Average on 32 head was \$1,238.00.

Grand Champion Open Hereford Females Pen of 5 by Weldon Winsauer, brought \$1,000 per head. Siesta Herefords of Raymondville, Texas, purchased the grand champion pen for \$5,000. Wesley Theuret of Kenedy, Texas, had the Reserve Champion Pen of 5, which brought \$725 per head. The pen was purchased by B and B Land & Cattle of Goliad, Texas, for \$3,625. The open Hereford females brought an average of \$672 on 30 head.

Grand Champion True F-1 Bred Females Pen of 5 brought \$1,300 per head. N.R. Johnston of Kenedy, Texas, had the championship pen. F.A. Hause of Beeville purchased this pen for \$6,500. Mr. Johnston also consigned the Reserve Champion pen, which brought \$1,375 per head. Mr. Hause bought the pen of 5 for \$6,875. The average for True F-1 Bred Females was \$1,167.00 on 78 head.

True Open F-1 Females Grand Champion Pen of 5 was Cabeza Cattle Co. of Nixon, Texas. They brought \$875.00 per head. Frank Helvey from Hondo, Texas purchased the pen for \$4,375. Cabeza Cattle Co. also had the Reserve Champion pen of 5 that sold for \$850 per head. Gwosdz Three Farms of Sandia, Texas, purchased the pen for \$4,250.00. Average on 107 head was \$766.00.

Volume Buyers at the sale included the following: Lew Thompson of Pearsall, Texas; Frank Helvey of Hondo, Texas; F.A. Hause of Beeville, Texas; Audra Henke Port Lavaca, Texas; Siesta Herefords of Raymondville, Texas; and Gwosdz Three Farms of Sandia, Texas.

Capital Farm Credit and Livengood Feeds sponsored the sale.
