2012 South Texas Hereford Association Spring Sale Press Release

The South Texas Hereford Association hosted its annual spring sale on February 4, 2012, at Beeville Livestock Commission. Two hundred seven head of cattle were sold in the sale

Forty-eight bulls averaged \$2,774.00 per head. Grand Champion honors were taken Schmidt Herefords of Hondo, Texas. Lew Thompson located in Pearsall, Texas, purchased the bull for \$3,200.00. Winsauer Herefords of Beeville, Texas, consigned the Reserve Champion bull. David Urban of Flatonia, Texas, bought the animal for \$2,700.00. Other top selling bull consignors included: Charles Moscatelli, Victoria, Texas, \$4,200 and \$4,000; Schmidt Herefords, Hondo, Texas, \$4,000; \$3,800; \$3,500 and \$3,200; Case Ranch, Eldorado, Texas, \$3,800; \$3,750; \$3,500; and \$3,200; and Winsauer Herefords of Beeville, Texas, \$3,200. Other bull consignors included Dr. Larry Karrh of Boerne, Texas, and Walker Herefords of LaGrange, Texas.

Charles Moscatelli of Victoria, Texas, was awarded Grand Champion Bred Hereford Females Pen of 5, which sold for \$1,350 per head. Edward Roeder of Yorktown, Texas, purchased the winning pen for \$6,750. The 9 head of bred Hereford females averaged \$1,317 per head. Open Hereford females averaged \$1,350.00.

The nineteen true F-1 pairs averaged \$1,747 per head. Grand Champion True F-1 Pairs Pen of 5 brought \$1,900 per head. W.D. Cattle Co. of Floresville, Texas, had the championship pen. Ken Venable of V-Cross Ranch in Church Point, Louisiana, bought the pen for \$9,500. Claude Dugie of San Antonio, Texas, was awarded Grand Champion Bred True F-1 Females Pen of 5 which brought \$1,600 per head. Fred Westhoff of Edna, Texas, bought the pen of 5 for \$8,000. The average for True F-1 Bred Females was \$1,395 on 22 head.

True Open F-1 Females Grand Champion Pen of 5 was awarded to Lew Thompson of Pearsall, Texas. They brought \$1,450 per head. Coby Jones of Open Heart Ranch, Gatesville, Texas, purchased the pen for \$7,250. Edward Roeder of Yorktown, Texas, consigned

the Reserve Champion Pen of 5 that sold for \$1,275 per head. Ken Venable of V-Cross Ranch in Church Point, Louisiana, purchased the pen for \$6,375. Average on 106 head was a \$1,105.

Martin O'Connor of Victoria, Texas, and Lew Thompson of Pearsall, Texas, were the volume bull buyers. The female volume buyers at the sale included the following: V-Cross Ranch of Church Point, Louisiana; Open Heart Ranch of Gatesville, Texas; Mike Adams of Navasota, Texas; and Don Williams of Yoakum, Texas..

Capital Farm Credit , Livengood Feeds, Davy Ranch Supply , and Ezy-Lift sponsored the sale.
